Literacy

In literacy this half term we will be continuing with our Read Write INC phonics lessons.

We will be writing simple sentences that can be read by ourselves and others. Our topic of 'Terrific tales' will link into our literacy when we use our writing skills to re-tell some of our traditional tales.

Communication and language

This half term we will use our new speaking and listening skills to act out traditional tales using key vocabulary from the stories. We will continue to look at our 'You Choose' books to develop our ability to speak in full sentences.

Our listening skills will develop as we now join the whole school for assembly together.

Understanding of the world This term we will look at people who can help and 'stranger danger'

We will explore growing and the life cycles of plants, what plants need and how we can look after them.



Physical development

Our PE lessons this term will be 'Balance ability' We will learn how to ride bikes without stabilisers with our bike coach. This will happen on a Friday afternoon. All children need to be in pe kit without laces please.

<u>Maths</u>

In maths we will begin to look at halving and sharing. We will look at number bonds to 10. We will place numbers in and out of order and match them to their correct quantity. We will apply our maths skills to some problem-solving questions and then talk about how we found the answer.

Expressive arts and design.

This half term we will continue to explore structures and how to create these structures using junk modelling. We will complete some observational drawings of plants and animals and look at how we can use our art tools to add detail.
