



# REMOTE LEARNING GUIDE

## The Bromley Pensnett Primary School

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### How work is set?

Your child's work will be sent to you via text with a link to the learning platform Wakelet. You will receive regular links to Wakelet, please contact school if you do not receive these.

The majority of activities will have a PowerPoint or clip which will provide the information required for you to support your child to complete the tasks. There may also be, for example, a video clip of a story being read to your child, or a phonics session.

Once the introductory information has been viewed, the majority of the work set can be completed on paper. There may be links to websites which provide educational activities.

### How to return work?

To return your child's work, we will be using the Dojo App. Reminders of log-ins have been sent out to parents.

You will need to photograph your child's work and upload it to your Dojo. Please return work on a daily basis.

The work your child completes may be in a variety of forms, you may need to photograph:

- Your child completing an activity
- The work your child has completed on paper
- The computer screen with the completed work on (you do not need to print out the page to then photograph it)
- A piece of art work or a model
